**skill level:** Intermediate  
One size

**finished measurements**  
Approximately 19" around  
x 4½" wide

**Yarn**

1 hank **BERROCO VINTAGE  
CHUNKY** (100 grs), #6106 Smoke

**needles and notions**

Straight knitting needles, size 10  
(6.00 mm) or size to obtain gauge  
Cable needle (cn)  
2 st markers.

**gauge**

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" in Cable Pat  
TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK  
GAUGE

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## STITCH GLOSSARY

**C6F:** Sl 3 sts to cn and hold in FRONT, k3, k3 from cn

**C6B:** Sl 3 sts to cn and hold in BACK, k3, k3 from cn

## HEADBAND

Cast on 21 sts.

**Cable Pattern: Set-Up Row (WS):** Sl 1 wyif, [k1, p1] twice, k1, pm, p9, pm, [k1, p1] twice, k2.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl 1 wyif, [k1, p1] twice, k1, sm, k9, sm, [k1, p1] twice, k2.

**Row 2 and all WS rows:** Sl 1 wyif, [k1, p1] twice, k1, sm, p9, sm, [k1, p1] twice, k2.

**Row 3:** Sl 1 wyif, [k1, p1] twice, k1, sm, C6F, k3, sm, [k1, p1] twice, k2.

**Row 5:** Rep Row 1.

**Row 7:** Sl 1 wyif, [k1, p1] twice, k1, sm, k3, C6B, sm, [k1, p1] twice, k2.

**Row 8:** Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1 – 8 until piece measures 19" (or desired length) from beg, end on WS with Row 8. Bind off in pattern, leaving a 10" long end for sewing.

## FINISHING

Sew cast-on and bound-off edges together. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

**beg:** beginning  
**cn:** cable needle  
**k:** knit  
**p:** purl  
**pat(s):** pattern(s)  
**pm:** place marker  
**rep:** repeat  
**RS:** right side  
**sl:** slip  
**sm:** slip marker  
**st(s):** stitch(es)  
**WS:** wrong side  
**wyif:** with yarn in front
