One size

finished measurements

Approximately 19" around brim,
(20" around hat body) x 9" long

yarn

BERROCO BENTO (100gr): 2 balls
#8742 Yuzu (MC)

Optional: **BERROCO ANDEAN MIST** (25 grs): 1 ball #6324
Pantanal (CC)

needles and notions

16" circular needles, sizes 6
(4.00 mm) and 7 (4.50 mm) *or size
to obtain gauge*

1 set double pointed needles
(dpns), size 7 (4.50 mm) for crown
Tapestry needle
1 stitch marker

gauge

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" in St st on
larger needle
22 sts and 28 rows = 4" in ribbing
on smaller needle

*To save time, take time to check
gauge.*

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NOTE: We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.

NOTE

Hat is worked in the round from bottom to top following chart or written directions.

As you decrease for top, when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on circular needle, change to dpns, dividing sts onto 3 needles.

HAT

Brim: With smaller needle and MC, cast on 88 sts. Place marker and join for working in the round. Work even in k1, p1 ribbing for 11 rounds. Change to larger needle.

Body of Hat: Rnd 1: * K4, LT2, k2, repeat from * around.

Rnd 2: * K4, p1, k3, repeat from * around.

Rnd 3: * K5, LT2, k1, repeat from * around.

Rnd 4: * K4, p2, k2, repeat from * around.

Rnd 5: * K6, LT2, repeat from * around.

Rnd 6: * K4, p3, k1, repeat from * around.

Rnd 7: * K2, RT2, k4, repeat from * around.

Rnd 8: * K3, p1, k4, repeat from * around.

Rnd 9: * K1, RT2, k5, repeat from * around.

Rnd 10: * K2, p2, k4, repeat from * around.

Rnd 11: * RT2, k6, repeat from * around.

Rnd 12: * K1, p3, k4, repeat from * around.

Repeat Rnds 1-12 twice more more (36 rounds total).

Shape Crown: Rnd 1: * K4, SSK, k2, repeat from * around – 77 stitches.

Rnd 2: Knit

Rnd 3: * K4, SSK, k1, repeat from * around – 66 stitches.

Rnd 4: Knit

Rnd 5: * K4, SSK, repeat from * around – 55 stitches.

Rnd 6: Knit

Rnd 7: * K2, k2tog, k1, repeat from * around – 44 stitches.

Rnd 8: Knit



Rnd 9: * K1, k2tog, k1, repeat from * around – 33 stitches.

Rnd 10: Knit

Rnd 11: * K2tog, k1 repeat from * around – 22 stitches.

Rnd 12: Knit

Rnd 13: SSK around – 11 stitches.

FINISHING

Break off yarn, leaving an 8" tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle and draw through remaining 11 sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure.

Optional: With CC, make a 3" pompom and attach securely to hat.

Weave in all ends. Wet block hat to measurements.


KEY TO CHART

-  knit
 purl
 LT2 (Left Twist)
 RT2 (Right Twist)
 pattern repeat

CHART NOTES

Work from right to left on every rnd.

TRIBUTARY CHART



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

CC: contrast color

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

LT2 (Left Twist): Skip 1 stitch, knit second stitch through back loop, then knit both stitches together through back loop

MC: main color

p: purl

pm: place marker

RT2 (Right Twist): Knit 2 stitches together, leaving them on the left hand needle, then knit the first stitch again slipping both stitches to the right hand needle.)

rnd(s): round(s)

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

Stockinette stitch (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

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
