**Skill level:** Intermediate One size

#### finished measurements

Approximately 8" around x 8" long

#### varn

#### BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA

(100 grs): 1 hank each #62100 Eiderdown (C1), #62168 Candy Floss Mix (C2), and #6292 Tiger's Eye Mix (C3)

#### needles and notions

1 set each double pointed needles (dpns), sizes 2 (2.75 mm) and 4 (3.50 mm) or size to obtain gauge 1 st marker Waste yarn to hold sts for afterthought thumb Tapestry needle

#### gauge

24 sts and 26 rows = 4" in Stockinette st following chart on larger needles To save time, take time to check gauge

#### NOTE

Do not carry yarn across more than 3 stitches on WS without twisting colors together. This prevents long loops.

#### RIGHT MITTEN

With smaller dpns and C1, cast on 48 sts. Divide sts evenly over 3 needles, place marker and join for working in the round.

**Cuff: Set Up Rib:** \* K1, p1, repeat from \* to around. Work in ribbing as established for 14 rounds more. Change to larger dpns and knit 1 rnd with C2.

Join C3 and work Rnds 1-15 of chart,

**Place Thumb:** Rnd 16: With C2, k1, knit the next 7 sts with waste yarn, leaving yarn tails hanging on RS of work, slip the 7 sts just worked from RH needle back to LH needle and knit them again with C2, knit to end in C2.

Work Rnds 1-15 of chart once more.

**Top Rib:** Change to smaller needles and work in ribbing as for cuff for 5 rounds. Bind off in ribbing.





#### LEFT MITTEN

Work as for Right Mitten until Rnd 15 of chart has been completed once.

**Place Thumb:** Rnd 16: With C2, knit to the last 8 stitches, knit the next 7 sts with waste yarn, leaving yarn tails hanging on RS of work, slip the 7 sts just worked from RH needle back to LH needle and knit them again with C2, k1 with C2. Complete as for Right Mitten.

#### **FINISHING**

**Thumbs:** Carefully unpick the waste yarn for the thumb openings. Place the top sts on one larger dpn and the bottom sts on second larger dpn. Join C1 in last top st, pick up and knit 2 sts in the gap between top and bottom sts, knit 7 bottom sts, pick up and knit 2 sts in gap before next needle, knit 7 top sts, place marker and join for working in the round – 18 sts. Divide sts over 3 (smaller) dpns. Knit 1 round. Work in ribbing as for cuff for 4 rounds. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Weave in all ends and block as desired..


