**sizes**

Directions are for women's size X-Small.  
 Changes for sizes Small, Medium, Large,  
 1X and 2X are in parentheses  
 To Fit Bust Size: 30(34-38-42-46-50)"

**finished measurements**

Bust (closed) – 36(40-44-48-52-56)"  
 Length – 26(27-28-30-32-34)" including  
 ribbing

**Note:** This garment was designed with  
 approximately 6" of ease. Please take this  
 into consideration when selecting your  
 size. Due to the nature of this design, the  
 garment will lengthen proportionately.  
 The largest garments will be nearer to a  
 coat length than the size Small shown.

**materials**

11(12-14-16-19-21) Hanks **BERROCO**  
**ABODE** (50 grs), #8824 River  
 Straight knitting needles, size 8 (5.00 mm)  
 OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE  
 29" Length circular knitting needle, size 8  
 (5.00 mm)  
 1 St holder  
 Three 1" buttons

**gauge**

18 sts = 4"; 34 rows = 4" in Pat St  
 TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK  
 GAUGE

**note**

This garment is worked in one piece, then  
 folded and seamed to create the finished  
 sweater. The bottom ribbing and sleeve  
 cuffs are picked up and worked down  
 during finishing.

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**NOTE:** We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.

## PATTERN STITCH

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Rows 2, 3 and 4:** Purl.

**Rows 5 and 6:** Knit.

Rep these 6 rows for Pat St.

## LEFT FRONT

Using straight needles, cast on 41(45-50-54-59-63) sts. Work even in Pat St for 5", end on WS. Sl sts to holder. Make a note of the Pat St row you ended with.

## LEFT SLEEVE

Using straight needles, cast on 5 sts. Work even in Pat St for 2 rows, end on WS.

**Inc Row (RS):** Work in Pat St for 1 st, M1, work in Pat St to last st, M1, work 1 st – 7 sts. Continuing to work in Pat St, rep this inc every RS row 19(19-19-20-21) times more – 45(45-45-47-49) sts. Work even until piece measures 5" from beg, end WS with same row as left front.

**Joining Row (RS):** Working across left sleeve, work 1 st in Pat St, M1, work to end in Pat St, then work 41(45-50-54-59-63) sts of left front from holder – 87(91-96-100-107-113) sts. Work 1 row even, end on WS.

**Inc Row (RS):** Work in Pat St for 1 st, M1, work in Pat St to end – 88(92-97-101-108-114) sts. Continuing to work in Pat St, rep this inc every RS row 17(17-17-22-23-27) times more – 105(109-114-123-130-139) sts. Work even if necessary until piece measures 9(9-9-10-10-11)" from cast-on edge

of left front, end on WS.

**Dec Row (RS):** Work 1 st in Pat St, k2 tog or p2 tog (depending on which row you are working), work in Pat St to end – 104(108-113-122-129-138) sts. Rep this dec every RS row 23 times more, end on RS – 81(85-90-99-106-115) sts.

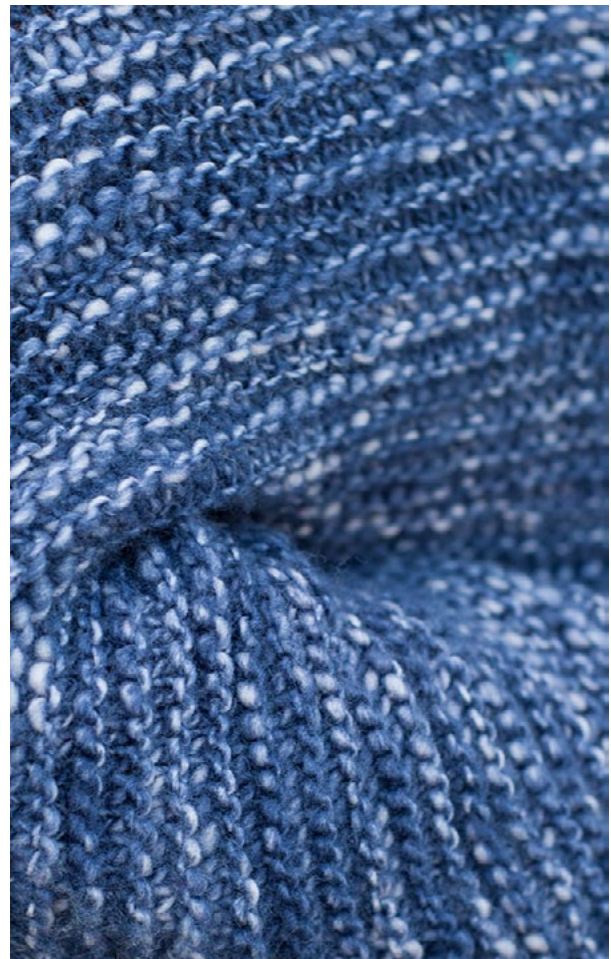
## BODY

**Next Row (WS):** Work in Pat St to end, then cast on 22 sts using Cable Cast-On Method – 103(107-112-121-128-137) sts. Work even until piece measures 18(20-22-24-26-28)" above last group of cast-on sts, end on WS.

## RIGHT SLEEVE

Bind off 22 sts at beg of the next row – 81(85-90-99-106-115) sts. Work 1 row even in Pat St.

**Inc Row (RS):** Work in Pat St for 1 st, M1, work in Pat St to end – 82(86-91-100-107-116) sts. Rep this inc every RS row 5 times more, end on WS – 87(91-96-105-112-121) sts.



**Buttonhole Row (RS):** Work in Pat St for 1 st, M1, work in Pat St to last 5 sts, bind off 2 sts, work to end.

**Next Row (WS):** Work in Pat St, cast on 2 sts over sts bound off on previous row – 88(92-97-106-113-122) sts. Continuing to work in Pat St, rep Inc Row every RS row 16 times more, end on WS – 104(108-113-122-129-138) sts.

**Dec Row (RS):** Work in Pat St for 1 st, k2 tog or p2 tog (depending on which row you are working), work in Pat St to end – 103(107-112-121-128-137) sts. Rep this dec every RS row 5 times more, end on WS – 98(102-107-116-123-132) sts.

**Buttonhole Row (RS):** Work 1 st in Pat St, k2 tog or p2 tog (depending on which row you are working), work in Pat St to last 5 sts, bind off 2 sts, work to end.

**Next Row (WS):** Work in Pat St, cast on 2 sts over sts bound off on previous row – 97(101-106-115-122-131) sts. Continuing to work in Pat St, rep Dec Row every RS row 11(11-11-16-16-19) times more, end on WS – 86(90-95-99-106-112) sts. Make a note of which Pat St row you ended with.

**Divide for Right Front: Next Row (RS):** Work in Pat St over 45(45-45-45-47-49) sts, sl remaining 41(45-50-54-59-63) sts to holder for right front.

**Right Sleeve:** Work 1 row even in Pat St, end on WS.

**Dec Row (RS):** Work in Pat St for 1 st, k2 tog or p2 tog (depending on which row you are working), work in Pat St to last 3 sts, k2 tog or p2 tog, work last st – 43(43-43-43-45-47) sts. Rep Dec Row every RS row 19(19-19-19-20-21) times more, end on WS. Bind off remaining 5 sts.

## RIGHT FRONT

With RS facing, sl 41(45-50-54-59-63) sts from holder to needle. Join yarn and work even in Pat St for 4½", end on WS.

**Buttonhole Row (RS):** Work in Pat St to last 5 sts, bind off 2 sts, work to end.

**Next Row (WS):** Work in Pat St, cast on 2 sts over sts bound off on previous row. Work even until piece measures 5" above division of right sleeve and right front, end on WS. Bind off.

## FINISHING

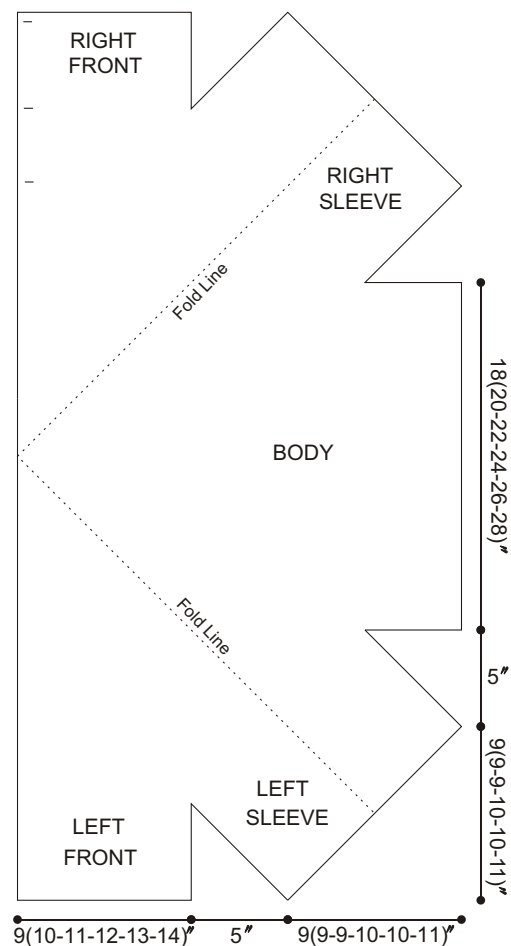
**Sleeve Cuffs:** With RS facing, pick up and k69(69-72-78-84-90) sts along lower edge of sleeve (see schematic).

**Ribbing: Row 1 (WS):** K1, \* p1, k2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, end p1, k1.

**Row 2 (RS):** P1, \* sl 1 WYIB, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, sl 1 WYIB, p1. Rep these 2 rows until ribbing measures 3", end on WS. Bind off.

Lay piece flat with WS facing so that it looks like schematic. Fold left and right fronts towards body along dotted lines (this will fold sleeves in half). Sew side and sleeve seams.

**Lower Band:** With RS facing, using circular needle, beg at left front edge, pick up and k56(62-65-71-74-80) sts along lower edge of left front, 119(125-128-134-137-143) sts along lower edge of back, then 56(62-65-71-74-80) sts along lower edge of right front – 231(249-258-276-285-303) sts. Work in ribbing same as sleeves for 3", end on WS. Bind off. Sew on buttons.



## ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

### Knit

**beg:** beginning  
**CC:** contrasting color  
**cn:** cable needle  
**cont:** continue  
**dec:** decrease  
**dpn:** double pointed needles  
**est:** established  
**inc:** increase  
**K:** knit  
**KSP:** Knit 1, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift 2nd stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on RH needle (1 stitch decreased).  
**K2SP:** Knit 2 together, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift second stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on right hand needle (2 stitches decreased).  
**LH:** left hand  
**lp(s):** loop(s)  
**LT2 (Left Twist):** Skip 1 stitch, knit second stitch through back loop, then knit both stitches together through back loop  
**MC:** main color  
**M1k:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch (1 stitch increased).  
**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch (1 stitch increased).  
**p:** purl  
**pat(s):** pattern(s)  
**pm:** place marker  
**psso:** pass slip stitch over knit stitch  
**p2sso:** pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch  
**rem:** remaining  
**rep:** repeat  
**RH:** right hand  
**rnd(s):** round(s)  
**RS:** right side  
**RT2 (Right Twist):** Knit 2 stitches together, leaving them on the left hand needle, then knit the first stitch again slipping both stitches to the right hand needle.  
**SKP:** slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over  
**sl:** slip  
**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.  
**st(s):** stitch(es)

**TBL:** through back loop(s)  
**tog:** together  
**WS:** wrong side  
**wyib:** with yarn in back  
**wyif:** with yarn in front  
**yo:** yarn over  
**end on WS:** end having just completed a Wrong Side row.  
**end on RS:** end having just completed a Right Side row  
**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle. Reverse **St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.  
**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

### Crochet

**bphdc (back post half double crochet):** Yarn over, insert hook from back to front to back around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on even # or wrong side rows).  
**bptr (back post triple):** Yarn over twice, insert hook from back to front around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.  
**ch:** chain  
**dc:** double crochet  
**fphdc (front post half double crochet):** Yarn over, insert hook from front to back to front around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on odd # or right side rows)  
**fptr (front post triple):** Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.  
**hdc:** half double crochet  
**hdctbl:** Half double crochet worked in the back loop  
**hdctfl:** Half double crochet worked in the front loop  
**sl st:** slip stitch  
**sp:** space  
**tr:** treble
