Berroco Partridge Phil

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**skill level:** Intermediate

One size

**finished measurements**

Approximately 8" long (from beak to end of tail) x 7" around belly (at widest part)

**materials**

1 Ball **BLACKSTONE TWEED** (50 grs)

#2685 Log Cabin (MC) and a small

amount #2614 Cranberry Bog (CC)

1 Set (4) double pointed knitting

needles (dpns), size 7 (4.50 mm) OR

SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

1 St marker

Tapestry needle

Small amount of fiber fill stuffing

**gauge**

18 st and 25 rnds = 4" in St st

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK

GAUGE

Free Pattern



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**NOTE:** We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

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## NOTE

Head is shaped using short rows. When working these rows, you will work part way across, wrap and turn, then work in the opposite direction, leaving some sts unworked.

## STITCH GLOSSARY

### Wrap and Turn

When knitting, bring yarn to the front, sl next st to RH needle, turn, bring yarn to the front, sl same st to RH needle, bring yarn across slipped st and purl as directed - slipped st is now a wrapped st.

When purling, sl next st to RH needle, bring yarn across slipped st and to the back, turn, sl same st to RH needle, bring yarn across slipped st to the back, then knit as directed - slipped st is now a wrapped st.

### TAIL

With MC, cast on 6 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles and join, being careful not to twist sts. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Knit 1 rnd.

**Inc Rnd 1:** \* K1, M1, k1, M1, k1, rep from \* once more - 10 sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

**Inc Rnd 2:** \* K1, M1, k3, M1, k1, rep from \* once more - 14 sts.

Knit 7 rnds.

**Inc Rnd 3:** \* K1, M1, k5, M1, k1, rep from \* once more - 18 sts.

Knit 2 rnds.

### BODY

**Inc Rnd 1:** K1, M1, k2, M1, k3, M1, (k2, M1) 3 times,



k3, M1, k2, M1, k1 - 26 sts.

Knit 2 rnds.

**Belly: Inc Rnd 2:** K1, M1, k3, M1, k5, M1, k3, M1, k14 - 30 sts.

Knit 19 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 1:** K1, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k1, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k to end - 26 sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

**Dec Rnd 2:** (K1, k2tog) 4 times, k2, k2tog, k7, k2tog, k1 - 20 sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

### HEAD

**Short Rows:** K18, wrap and turn, p7, wrap and turn, k6, wrap and turn, p5, wrap and turn, k4, wrap and turn, p3, wrap and turn, knit all the way around to beg of rnd (each time you come to a wrapped st, slip wrap back over st and onto LH needle, then k the wrap along with its accompanying st tog - this prevents holes) - 20 sts. Knit 1 more rnd, treating any wrapped sts as in previous rnd. Knit 1 rnd.

**Dec Rnd 1:** \* K2, k2tog, rep from \* around - 15 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Using cast on tail, sew tail closed, then stuff body and most of the head with fiber fill.

**Dec Rnd 2:** \* K1, k2tog, rep from \* around - 10 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Stuff remainder of head. Break off yarn leaving an 8" long tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needle.

Fasten off.

**BEAK**

With CC, cast on 8 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles and join, being careful not to twist sts. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Knit 2 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 1:** \* K1, k2tog, k1, rep from \* once more – 6 sts.

**Dec Rnd 2:** \* Sl 1, k2tog, pssso, rep from \* once more – 2 sts. Break off yarn leaving a 6" long tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts. Fasten off.

**WINGS**

With MC, cast on 20 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles and join, being careful not to twist sts. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Knit 5 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 1:** K1, k2tog, k14, SSK, k1 – 18 sts. Knit 3 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 2:** K1, k2tog, k12, SSK, k1 – 16 sts. Knit 3 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 3:** K1, k2tog, k10, SSK, k1 – 14 sts. Knit 1 rnd.

**Dec Rnd 4:** K1, k2tog, k8, SSK, k1 – 12 sts.

**Dec Rnd 5:** K1, k2tog, k6, SSK, k1 – 10 sts.

**Dec Rnd 6:** K1, k2tog, k4, SSK, k1 – 8 sts.

**Dec Rnd 7:** K1, k2tog, k2, SSK, k1 – 6 sts. Break off yarn leaving an 8" long tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needles. Fasten off.

**FEET (Make 2)**

With 2 dpns, using CC, cast on 3 sts. Work I-Cord as follows:

**Row 1 (RS):** \* K3, do not turn. Slide sts to beg of needle to work next row from RS. Rep from \* until cord measures 1" from beg.

**Next Row (RS):** K3. Turn.

**Next Row (WS):** P3, turn.

**Next Row (RS):** Sl 1, k1, sl 1. Turn.

**Next Row (WS):** Sl 1, p1, sl 1. Turn. Sl 1, k2tog, pssso. Fasten off last st.

**FINISHING**

Stuff beak with fiber fill and sew beak to head.

Stuff wings and sew one wing to each side of body, slightly slanted so that there is approximately 2" across back between top edges of wings. Sew feet in center of lower side of belly, approximately 1" apart.

## ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

### Knit

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**beg:** beginning  
**CC:** contrasting color  
**cdd (centered double decrease):** Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.  
**cn:** cable needle  
**cont:** continue  
**dec:** decrease  
**dpn:** double pointed needles  
**est:** established  
**inc:** increase  
**K:** knit  
**k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s)  
**k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together  
**k3tog:** Knit 3 stitches together  
**LH:** left hand  
**MC:** main color  
**M1k:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1L:** Work as for M1k.  
**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1pL:** Work as for M1p.  
**M1pR:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).  
**M1R:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).  
**p:** purl  
**p tbl:** purl through the back loop(s)  
**pat(s):** pattern(s)  
**pm:** place marker  
**pssso:** pass slip stitch over knit stitch  
**p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together  
**p2sso:** pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch  
**rem:** remaining  
**rep:** repeat  
**RH:** right hand  
**rnd(s):** round(s)  
**RS:** right side  
**sl:** slip  
**sm:** slip marker  
**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand

needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**TBL:** through back loop(s)

**tog:** together

**WS:** wrong side

**wyib:** with yarn in back

**wyif:** with yarn in front

**yo:** yarn over

**end on WS:** end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

**end on RS:** end having just completed a Right Side row

**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**Reverse St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

### Crochet

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**ch:** chain

**dc:** double crochet

**hdc:** half double crochet

**sc:** single crochet

**sl st:** slip stitch

**sp:** space

**tr:** treble
