SQUARE A

With straight needles, cast on 216 sts. Work even in Garter St for 2". Keeping 12 sts on each side in Garter St and remaining sts in St st, work even until piece measures 34" from beg, end on WS. Work even in Garter St until piece measures 36" from beg, end on WS. Bind off knitwise.



SQUARE B

BELFLOWERS PAT (Multiple of 17 sts + 2)

Note: Due to the nature of this pattern, the number of sts will change from row to row.

Row 1 (RS): P2, * yo, k2tog, yo, (k2tog) 3 times, k2, yo, k3, yo, sl 1, k1, pssso, yo, p2, rep from * across.

Row 2 and all WS rows: K the k sts and p the p sts as they face you.

Row 3: P2, * yo, k2tog, (k3tog) twice, yo, k1, yo, k2, (sl 1, k1, pssso, yo) twice, p2, rep from * across.

Row 5: P2, * yo, k4 tog, yo, k3, yo, k2, (sl 1, k1, pssso, yo) twice, p2, rep from * across.

Row 7: P2, * yo, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, yo, k2, (sl 1, k1, pssso, yo) twice, p2, rep from * across.

Row 9: P2, * yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k2, (sl 1, k1, pssso) twice, (sl 1, k1, pssso, yo) twice, p2, rep from * across.

Row 11: P2, * (yo, k2tog) twice, k2, yo, k1, yo, (sl 1, k2tog, pssso) twice, sl 1, k1, pssso, yo, p2, rep from * across.

Row 13: P2, * (yo, k2tog) twice, k2, yo, k3, yo, sl 1, k3tog, pssso, yo, p2, rep from * across.

Row 15: P2, * (yo, k2tog) twice, k2, yo, sl 1, k1, pssso, k2, yo, k1, yo, sl 1, k1, pssso, yo, p2, rep from * across.

Row 16: Rep Row 2.

Rep these 16 rows for Bellflower Pat.

With straight needles, cast on 104 sts. Work even in Bellflower Pat until piece measures 18" from beg, end on WS. Bind off.



SQUARE C

STITCH GLOSSARY

MB

K in front, back, front, back, then front of next st (5 sts made from 1); (turn, p5, turn, k5) twice; pass the first 4 sts over the last st – 1 st remains

DIAGONAL SQUARES (Make 16)

With straight needles, cast on 71 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K34, k3tog TBL, k34 – 69 sts.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: K33, k3tog TBL, k33 – 67 sts.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: K32, k3tog TBL, k32 – 65 sts.

Row 6: Knit. Continuing to dec 2 sts at center in this manner every RS row, work 6 rows in St st, then 6 rows in Garter st – 53 sts.

Row 19: (K2tog, yo) 12 times, k1, k3tog TBL, k1, (yo, k2tog) 12 times – 51 sts.

Rows 20, 22, 24, 26 and 28: Knit.

Row 21: (K2tog, yo) 12 times, k3tog TBL, (yo, k2tog) 12 times – 49 sts.

Row 23: (K2tog, yo) 11 times, k1, k3tog TBL, k1, (yo, k2tog) 11 times – 47 sts.


Row 25: (K2tog, yo) 11 times, k3tog TBL, (yo, k2tog) 11 times – 45 sts.

Row 27: (K2tog, yo) 10 times, k1, k3tog TBL, k1, (yo, k2tog) 10 times – 43 sts.

Rows 29 – 32: Work in Garter St, continuing to dec 2 sts at center as on previous rows.

Rows 33 – 36: Work in St st, continuing to dec 2 sts at center as on previous rows – 35 sts.

Row 37: K4, (MB, k5) twice, k3tog TBL, (k5, MB) twice, k4 – 33 sts. Continuing to dec 2 sts at center as on previous rows, work 3 more rows in St st, 8 rows in Garter St, 6 rows St st, then work in Garter St. When 3 sts remain, end on WS. K3tog. Fasten off. Sew tog following diagram – the center diagonal line on each square should go in the direction of the center arrows on the diagram with the final k3tog at the point of the arrow.

**SQUARE D**

With straight needles, using Color A, cast on 96 sts. Knit 6 rows. Knit 2 rows Color D, 2 rows Color A, then 1 row Color C, end on RS. With Color A, purl 2 rows, knit 1 row, purl 1 row, end on RS. Purl 1 row Color C. Knit 2 rows Color A. Knit 2 rows Color D. Knit 2 rows Color A, end on WS. Beg with a p row, work even in Reverse St st, keeping 4 sts at each side in Garter St. Work 2 rows Color A, * (2 rows Color B, 2 rows Color A) twice, 10 rows Color B, 2 rows Color A, (2 rows Color B, 2 rows Color A) twice, 10 rows Color A, rep from * until piece measures 13 1/2" from beg, end on WS. Knit 2 rows Color A, 2 rows Color D, then 2 rows Color A. Knit 1 row Color C. With Color A, purl 2 rows, knit 1 row, purl 1 row, end on RS. Purl 1 row Color C. Knit 2 rows Color A, 2 rows Color D, then 6 rows Color A, end on WS. Bind off knitwise.

FINISHING

With RS facing, using crochet hook and Color D, work 1 row of Chain St up each edge just inside of Garter St borders. Work a second row of Chain St up each edge 1/2" in from the first row. With tapestry needle and Color C, embroider 1 row of back stitch inside first row of chain st and outside second row of chain st on each side as in photo.

Knit

beg: beginning

CC: contrasting color

cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

cn: cable needle

cont: continue

dec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

est: established

inc: increase

K: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)

k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together

k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together

LH: left hand

MC: main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining

rep: repeat

RH: right hand

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
