

# Nye

**skill level** Intermediate  
One size

**finished measurements**

Approximately 19" wide around brim,  
20" around hat body x 9" long

**yarn**

**BERROCO ULTRA WOOL** (100g):  
#33154 1 ball

**needles and notions**

16" circular needle(s), sizes 6 and 7  
(4.00 and 4.50 mm) *or size to obtain  
gauge*

Double-pointed needles in larger size  
to work crown

Tapestry needle

1 stitch marker

**gauge**

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" in Stockinette  
stitch

22 sts and 28 rows = 4" in k1, p1  
ribbing on smaller needles.

*To save time, take time to check gauge.*

## NOTE

Hat is worked in the round from bottom to top following chart.

As you decrease for top, switch to dpns when there are too few sts to comfortably continue working on circular needles.

## HAT

### Brim

With smaller needle, cast on 96 sts. Place marker and join, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in k1, p1 ribbing for 11 rounds. Change to larger needles.



### Body of Hat

Begin working in pattern from Nye Chart, working the 12-stitch repeat 8 times on each round. Work Rnds 1–24, then work Rnds 1–20 once more.

### Shape Crown

**Rnd 1:** \* P2, SSK, k5, k2tog, p1, repeat from \* to the end of the round—80 sts.

**Rnd 2:** \* P2, k1, p4, k2tog, p1, repeat from \* to the end of the round—72 sts.

**Rnd 3:** \* P2, SSK, k2, k2tog, p1, repeat from \* to the end of the round—56 sts.

**Rnd 4:** \* P2, k1 p1, k2tog, p1, repeat from \* to 1 stitch before the end of the round—48 sts.

**Rnd 5:** Sl 1, remove beg-of-rnd marker, slip the same stitch back to LH needle, replace marker, p3tog, \* sl 1, k2tog, pssso, p3tog, repeat from \* to the last 3 stitches, sl 1, k2tog, pssso—16 stitches remain.

**Rnd 6:** \* K2tog, repeat from \* to end—8 stitches remain.

## FINISHING

Break off yarn, leaving an 8" tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle and draw through remaining 8 sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure.

Weave in all ends. Wet block hat to measurements.


## NYE CHART

## CHART KEY

-  knit  
 purl  
 sl 1 to cn and hold to FRONT, k1, k1 from cn  
 sl 1 to cn and hold to BACK, k1, k1 from cn  
 sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k1, k2 from cn  
 sl 1 to cn and hold to FRONT, k2, k1 from cn

## CHART NOTES

Work from right to left on every rnd.



## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS &amp; TERMS

**beg:** beginning  
**cn:** cable needle  
**k:** knit  
**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together  
**LH:** left hand  
**p:** purl  
**p3tog:** purl 3 stitches together  
**pssso:** pass slipped stitch over knit stitch  
**rnd(s):** round(s)  
**sl:** slip  
**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.  
**st(s):** stitch(es)

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
